❖ **Category: Office Care**

- Procedure Codes: 99201 – 99205, 99211 – 99215

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 99201-99205 Office or Other outpatient Service, New patient
- ◆ 99211-99215 Office or Other outpatient Service, Established patient

❖ **Category: Preventive Medicine**

- Procedure Codes: 99381-99387, 99391-99397, 94772

Description of codes under capitation:

- ◆ 99381-99387 Preventive Medicine Services, New patient
- ◆ 99391-99397 Preventive Medicine Services, Established patient
- ◆ 94772 Circadian Respiration Pattern, 12-24 hrs, infant

❖ **Category: Hospital Care**

- Procedure Codes: 99221-99223, 99231-99233, 99238-99239

Description of codes under capitation:

- ◆ 99221-99223 Hospital Inpatient Services, Initial
- ◆ 99231-99233 Hospital Inpatient Services, subsequent
- ◆ 99238-99239 Hospital Discharge Services

❖ **Category: Hospital Observation Services**

- Procedure Codes: 99217-99220, 99234-99236

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 99217-99220 Hospital Observation Discharge Services
- ◆ 99234-99236 Hospital Observation Services

❖ **Category: Nursing Facility Services**

- Procedure Codes: 99304-99337

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 99304-99306 E/M of a new or established patient. Requires three key components.
  - 1) Detailed interval history
  - 2) Comprehensive examination
  - 3) Medical decision making that is straightforward or of low complexity, moderate complexity to high complexity.
- ◆ 99307-99310 Subsequent nursing facility care (per day) which requires at least 2 of 3 components:
  - 1) Problem-focused interval history
  - 2) Problem-focused examination
  - 3) Medical decision making that is straightforward or of low complexity, moderate complexity to high complexity.
- ◆ 99315-99316 Nursing Facility Discharge Services.
- ◆ 99324-99328 New patient Domiciliary, Rest Home or Custodial Care Services. Requires these three components:
  - 1) Problem-focused history

- 2) Problem-focused examination
- 3) Medical decision making that is straightforward or of low complexity, moderate complexity to high complexity.

- ◆ 99334-99337 Established patient Domiciliary, Rest Home or Custodial Care Services. Requires at least 2 of 3 components:
  - 1) Problem-focused interval history
  - 2) Problem-focused examination
  - 3) Medical decision making that is straightforward or of low complexity, moderate complexity to high complexity.

❖ **Category: Special Services**

- Procedure Codes: 99050 – 99058

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 99050-99058 Office Services provided on an emergency basis. Services requested after office hours in addition to basic services.

❖ **Category: Therapeutic Injections**

- Procedure Codes: 90782, 90783, 90784, 90788

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 90782 Therapeutic or diagnostic injection (specify material injected), subcutaneous or intramuscular.
- ◆ 90783 intra-arterial
- ◆ 90784 intravenous
- ◆ 90788 intramuscular injection of antibiotic (specify)

❖ **Category: Venipuncture/Handling**

- Procedure Codes: 36415, 99000

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 36415 Routine venipuncture or finger/heel/ear stick for collection of specimen(s)
- ◆ 99000 Handling specimen for transfer to a laboratory

❖ **Category: Diagnostic Procedures**

- Procedure Codes: 93000, 93005, 93010, 93040, 93041, 93042

Description of Codes Under Capitation:

- ◆ 93000 Electrocardiogram (ECG)
- ◆ 93005 Tracing only without interpretation and report
- ◆ 93010 Interpretation and report only
- ◆ 93040 Rhythm ECG one to three leads with interpretation and report.
- ◆ 93041 Tracing only without interpretation and report
- ◆ 93042 Interpretation and report only
